

## PHILLYSEEDS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS, FORM, AND CHECKLIST

Form dated 11.15.22 - updated on 11.09.23 re: 1) amounts, 2) timing of submissions & 3) alternative program

An eligible applicant must submit: 1) this form, 2) the essay, in the described format, 3) the required supporting documentation re: Awards& Honors and/or Employment & Internships, 4) a transcript or GED, in the form designated (official), and 5) two letters of recommendation.

#### ELIGIBILITY

- Be accepted as a full-time student by an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or trade/technical school;
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5 or B- or a corresponding percentage overall GED score (if less, see the PhillySEEDS Post-Secondary Education Assistance Program); and
- Be a resident of PHA public housing or a scattered site, a PHA housing choice voucher resident, or receive subsidized rent through a PHA partner household (verified by the lease), such as PAPMC, AME or a RAD site, for at least one (1) year.

#### AWARDS

Awards are based on funding availability and will be granted on a rolling basis. A minimum score of 12 points, out of 20 possible, is required for an award, based on the following categories:

Category	No. of Points
Essay	Up to 10
Employment & Internships, for past 2 yrs - require documentation	4*
<i>Community Service</i> (voluntary work intended to help people in a particular area) - for past 2 years <i>or</i> <i>Extracurricular Activities</i> (school or college activities pursued in addition to the normal course of study, such as sports, drama, music, chess) – for past 2 years	4
Awards & Honors/Leadership for past 2 yrs – require documentation or For Returning Students <sup>1</sup> – if ineligible for Awards & Honors or Extracurricular Activities points due to the 2-yr time requirement, uniquely compelling circumstances may be considered	2*

\* **Points for Awards & Honors and/or Employment & Internships require supporting documentation**, such as an award certificate or a signed letter from the organization.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> "Returning Students" are any who were not in an academic environment for the last 2 years

If an applicant receives at least 12 points, as noted above, scholarships will be awarded as follows:

- \$5,000 scholarships minimum GPA of 3.3
- \$4,000 scholarships minimum GPA of 3.0
- \$3,000 scholarships minimum GPA of 2.5

#### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION TIMELINE

Completed applications, with all required documents, should be received between March 1 and June 15 of the year for which the applicant is applying.

Scholarship awards are dependent on the amount of PhillySEEDS funding available per year, which is limited.

Decisions will be made on a rolling basis by the evaluation committee, based on when applications are received, so earlier applicants will have a better chance of being sure to receive funding.

#### SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENTS

Scholarship payments are only to be made to the educational institution, absent both extraordinary circumstances and written approval by the Board of PhillySEEDS.

Scholarship payments are to be used to pay for tuition and fees required for enrollment or attendance at the educational institution, or for fees, books, supplies, and equipment required for courses at the educational institution.

### APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Please use the checklist below to ensure that you are eligible and have submitted all items below. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- ☐ Are a **resident of PHA** public housing or a scattered site, a PHA housing choice voucher holder, or receive subsidized rent through a PHA partner household (verified by the lease), such as PAPMC, AME or a RAD site, for at least one (1) year
- □ Are **accepted as a full-time student** by an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or trade/technical school
- □ Have a **GPA of 2.5 or above** or an overall **GED score percentage equivalent**

□ Submit the **completed Scholarship Application Form** (pgs. 4-6 of this document)

 $\Box$  Submit an **essay** that is typed, double-spaced, in a 12 point font, in Word or .pdf (no screen shots), 500-750 words, and is on one of the following topics:

- 1. What are your future goals and aspirations? Where do you see yourself 10 years from now?
- 2. Write about how you have been significantly influenced by a particular person.
- 3. How has your education contributed to who you are today?
- 4. Pick an experience from your own life and explain how it has influenced your development.

Essays used in previous applications are not allowed and, if submitted, the applicant will be disqualified.

□ Submit an **official transcript or GED certificate**. A copy of an official document may suffice but PhillySEEDS may require a sealed copy or electronic equivalent from the issuing institution.

□ Submit **two** (2) **signed letters of recommendation**, from a teacher, school counselor, professor, or other instructor; a coach; or a community, club, or religious leader, *including their contact information* 

- □ Submit supporting documentation to receive points in the categories of: Awards& Honors, Employment & Internships (such as a certificate or copy of awards or honors, letters from work or internship supervisor and/or organization representative) or Section 6 for certain
- □ **Returning Students**, if you have been out of an academic environment for 2 years or more and may therefore not be eligible for the points in the categories of extracurricular activities or awards & honors, submit information regarding uniquely compelling circumstances, if applicable to your situation.
